

COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

ADVOCACY COMMITTEE

Works to advance the position, needs and projects of ANHA by presenting policy recommendations to agencies and elected officials; monitoring legislation and policy as it pertains to ANHA programs and administration; securing public sector funding; and influencing legislation and other forms of government interaction.

DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

Pursues ways to engage corporations, foundations and all levels of government in support of the programs and operation of the Alliance. Over the past few years, utility companies, small businesses and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to name a few have supported the Heritage Development Institute, the Annual Meeting of the Alliance in Washington, D.C. and have provided operational support to the organization.

PROGRAM COMMITTEE

Develops and manages programs and special projects for ANHA. Currently, the committee is working on: (1) NHA Economic Impact Survey 2008; (2) ANHA Annual Meeting Roundtable Presentations planned for Tuesday, February 17, 2009; (3) International Partnerships; and (4) Annual Survey Guidelines.

MEMBERSHIP AND MARKETING COMMITTEE

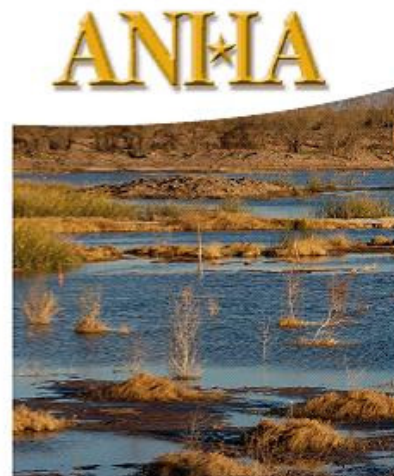
